When your neighborhood wants to hold a garage sale, don't forget to download a permit application at OKC.gov, or call the License Division at 405 297-2606 for a "paperless permit." Instead of a paper form, you get a permit number over the phone to post at your sale. Just click on "Garage Sales" on the left side of the page.

This site will give you all the information you need to hold a garage sale and, when you sign up to get a permit, you can advertise your sale there for free.
